Those patients affected may experience some of the following symptoms:

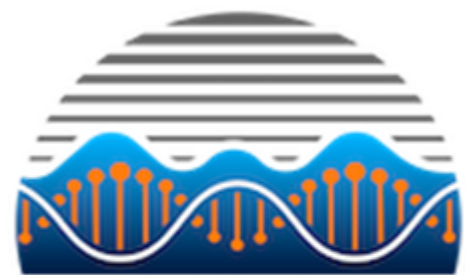
- **Thickened nails, whitish to yellow-brown discoloration, brittle, crumbly or ragged nail, a dark color, or distorted in shape, and a odor.**
