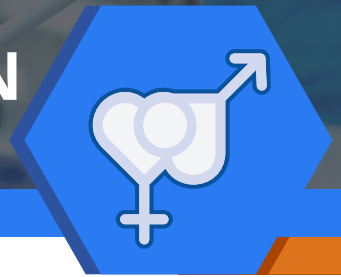


SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTION (STI) PANEL



PATHOGENS DETECTED

- Chlamydia trachomatis
- Gardnerella vaginalis
- Haemophilus ducreyi
- Herpes simplex 1
- Herpes simplex 2
- Neisseria gonorrhoeae
- Mycoplasma genitalium
- Mycoplasma hominis
- Treponema pallidum
- Trichomonas vaginalis
- Ureaplasma urealyticum
- Endogenous Control



SYMPTOMS TO CONSIDER:

Those patients affected may experience some of the following symptoms:

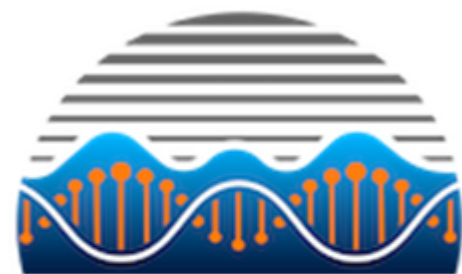
- **Unusual discharge from the penis; Vagina or anus; Pain during urination; sores, blisters, ulcers, warts or rashes in the genital area; Pain in the scrotum or testicles; Lumps and bumps on the genitals**



COLLECTION METHODS:

The Sexually Transmitted Infection panel can use samples collected with the following swab types:

- **Urine C&S Tube**
- **Endocervical Swab**
- **Cervical Brush w/ Pap Smear media**
- **Urethral Swab**
