Those patients affected may experience some of the following symptoms:

- *A strong, persistent urge to urinate; A burning sensation when urinating; and passing frequent, Small amounts of urine; Urine that appears cloudy; Urine that appears red; Bright pink or cola-colored — a sign of blood in the urine and strong-smelling urine*
